We are a great fun-loving group looking forward to sharing our experiences with like-minded Friendship Force members.

Sarasota is on the west coast of Florida and renowned for its flora and fauna particularly Selby Gardens and Mote Marine (notable for shark and dolphin research). The Journey will typically include Myakka State Park, Ringling Museum (home of Ringling Barnum and Bailey Circus) and Selby Gardens just to name a few.

Alajuela in Costa Rica is situated 20 kms northwest of the capital San Jose and the nearest airport. It has a stable temperature (25-30 degrees Celsius) and we will be visiting during its dry season. The province is rich in coffee and sugarcane plantations. Scheduled activities allow the ambassadors to learn about its history, nature and culture through such attractions as Poas Volcano, La Paz Waterfalls, Museums of Gold and Jade, Biological Reserves of Monteverde and La Tirimbina.

Mundo Maya De Tuxtla Gutierrez is a relatively new club branching off from FF of Tuxtla Gutierrez four years ago. The city is the capital of the state Chiapas. It is surrounded by many national parks containing waterfalls and ancient ruins. Visits will showcase their culture, restaurants, parks and museums including House of Crafts, Sumidero Canyon, City of Chiapa de Corzo amongst other activities.

If you want a different cultural experience but in an English-speaking country, this Journey to Albuquerque, New Mexico and to Austin, Texas, offers some unique highlights. Albuquerque is in the only bilingual state (Spanish/English) in the USA. Also the Pueblo peoples have been there for more than 1,000 years and form 10% of the population. Types of activities on offer are a trolley tour of Albuquerque, a day in Santa Fe, a tram ride to the Sandia Mountains and a visit to the spectacular Acoma Pueblo. Dates are 10 - 17 May.

We are planning to spend three nights in Houston/Galveston Bay, Texas, between the two Journeys visiting the Space Center Houston, the world renowned coastal visitor center at NASA's astronaut training and flight control complex. Dates are 17 - 20 May.

Austin is the state capital of Texas and the centre of an eclectic live music scene centred on country, blues and rock. The Austin Club has promised to treat us with "real Texan hospitality." Dates are 20 - 27 May.

To secure a position, I will be requesting \$500 as a deposit which comprises \$140 for each Journey (\$280) and the remainder of \$220 as a downpayment towards the final Journey costs. There are only three places available on these exciting Journeys to Western Colorado and Reno-Tahoe. Applications are required no later than 30 November 2018 to enable group bookings on Amtrak trains.

Our trip commences on 29 May with a three-night stay in Denver, Colorado, where we will spend three days sightseeing around the Mile High City. On 1 June we travel by Amtrak train to our first hosting with the Friendship Force Club of Western Colorado in Grand Junction.

Grand Junction is west of the Rocky Mountains on the Colorado plateau with access to the mountains, high desert and red-rock country. The city is located in the Colorado River valley, close to the border with Utah. There is a lot of prehistory in the area with a dinosaur museum and quarry and Native American petroglyphs. The Colorado national monument is adjacent to the town. There is so much to see in this area and a float trip on the Colorado River is a must.

On 8 June we will travel by Amtrak train to Salt Lake City, Utah for a break of 3 days, free time, between our 2 hostings. Here we can explore this beautiful city including Temple Square, Utah Natural History Museum, the city and surrounds and much more.

We travel by overnight Amtrak Train to Reno on 11 June, arriving there on the morning of 12 June for our week's stay with Reno-Tahoe club. At nearly a mile high, this region is nestled at the base of the eastern slope of the mighty Sierra Nevada Mountains. Lake Tahoe, which sparkles like a clear blue gem, is one hour's drive away. Virginia City, takes a person back to the Old West with narrow streets, shops and saloons that have bars and chandeliers dating back to the 1800s.

**This Journey has been set up so members can attend the FFI World Conference at Boulder, Colorado 23-27 July 2019. It is open for ambassadors globally.** Our first homestay prior to Conference is with FF Flathead Valley, an area beautifully situated in the north west corner of Montana, just west of the Rocky Mountains and only 65 km south of the Canadian border. A typical 7-day Journey might include visits to the museums of early settlers and Native Americans, a botanical garden tour, a visit to a bison ranch, a cruise on Flathead Lake, a chairlift ride at a ski resort, an outdoor concert and especially a full day exploring Glacier National Park.

We move to Denver where we will spend 2-3 days sightseeing around that Mile High City. We've reached July 23, and it's up the road to Boulder for the FFI World Conference until July 27. You will need to register for this online [here](#).

Our hosting after the Conference is with the FF of Cedar Rapids/Iowa. We travel to our hosting by overnight Amtrak which is an opportunity to see the countryside. This is a special corner of the world where fields of tall corn dance in the wind and where the land varies from flat to rolling hills covered with trees. But, make no mistake, they offer much more to visiting ambassadors. They have diverse cultures to explore including the Meskwaki Indian Settlement; Kalona, an Amish community; the Amanas, a German communal society and Czech Village, and immigrant workers from Bohemia. Our first hosting is with FF Cape of Good Hope. Most members of the club live in the southern suburbs of Cape Town about 24 km from the city centre. Their Mediterranean climate will be comfortable during our visit. Most importantly, we will be able to learn about them, their culture, and the way they live in this rainbow nation.

We then move east to FF Perth on the Swan River. There we will enjoy visiting old Perth at the Perth Mint (early gold mining), the Barrack Street Jetty precinct and the Bell Tower (where we may take part in the bit of bell ringing). No Journey is complete without a visit to beautiful Kings Park, where we can take in the views of the city and wander through lush lawns and natural bushland and do the tree top walk.
