<p>THU 10/31/ 19</p>		<p>Day 1 of tour (Egypt): Ambassadors will go from hosts' homes to Cairo International Airport, meet tour representative and fly to Aswan. Aswan Sightseeing</p> <p>Meet our tour representative at the airport, starting our tour with a flight to Aswan. When we land in Aswan, a tour representative will meet and greet us and then we will be taken for a bit of a tour in Aswan. First, we will be taken to see the renowned Aswan Dam on the Nile. We will also visit the spectacular Philae temple, devoted to the goddesses Isis and Hathor. Finally, we will be taken to see the Unfinished Obelisk, which is the largest known obelisk from ancient times, located at the quarries that provided the stone for the Pyramids. <p>FRI 11/01/ 19</p>			<p>Day 2 of tour (Egypt): Abu Simbel and start of Nile cruise</p> <p>An early start at 03.30am, when we will check-out of our hotel after getting our packed breakfast box. We will be taken from Aswan to Abu Simbel in an air-conditioned, private vehicle, the journey taking about 3.5 hours. We will visit the impressive Temple of Ramesses II at Abu Simbel. The structure is dedicated to the gods Ptah, Re-Harakhte, Amun-Re, and to Ramesses II. <p>SAT 11/02/ 19</p>		<p>Day 3 of tour (Egypt): Sail to Kom Ombo and Edfu</p> <p>Breakfast will be served on board as we sail to Kom Ombo, where we will visit the temple dedicated to two gods, Sobek and Haeroris. Back on board our cruiser, we will enjoy lunch as we sail to Edfu. Edfu boasts Egypt's best-preserved cult temple, the Temple of Horus. <p>SUN 11/03/ 19</p>		<p>Day 4 of tour (Egypt): Sightseeing in Luxor</p> <p>After breakfast on board, we can visit the famous Valley of the Kings at Luxor, the final resting place for 62 Pharaohs. We will see the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, built in the 15th century BC at El-Deir El-Bahari, as well as the spectacular Colossi of Memnon. <p>MON 11/04/ 19</p>		<p>Day 5 of tour (Egypt to Jordan): Luxor sightseeing and flight to Amman</p> <p>Breakfast will be served on board before we leave our cruise at 08:00 a.m. We will be taken to visit Karnak and Luxor temples before transferring to Luxor airport for our flight to Amman. Upon arrival at Amman International Airport, we will be met by a tour representative who will guide us to our collection point from where we will travel to our Amman hotel in an air-conditioned, private vehicle. Our representative will help us check-in to the hotel and will give us full details of our travel arrangements for the following day. We will visit an old monastery that overlooks the Jordan Valley, the Dead Sea, Jericho and Jerusalem. We will then carry on to Madaba and visit St. George's Church which houses a famous mosaic displaying a 6th century map of Palestine. We then proceed to the Dead Sea which is the lowest point on earth's land surface. There, we can relax and avail of the chance to float on the water of the Dead Sea. They laid the foundations of a huge commercial empire that stretched throughout the region. On arrival in Petra, we will begin the tour to the canyon, or Siq, on horseback. We will go on foot to the Treasury, the most outstanding monument. We will also get to see Pharaoh's Castle, the Street of Facades and the Royal Tombs.
